Queen Bees in The Heights

A tribute to the women who shaped The Heights, those who came before us, walk beside us, and are still yet to rise.

Texas Vodka, pineapple-rosemary shrub, fresh lemon juice, St. Germain, orange bitters, and splash of Topo Chico



The 19th Street Stroll

A nod to the original downtown Heights, where shoppers, strollers, and sweethearts have wandered for over a century.

The Woman's Club Sparkler

Inspired by the founders of the Houston Heights Woman's Club, sixteen spirited women who began meeting in homes in 1900, and built a legacy that still stands proudly at 1846 Harvard St.

Texas Rye Whiskey, Asian pear shrub, peach syrup, black walnut bitters with splash of sparkling wine



The Yale House Waltz

A tribute to the 120-year-old Yale House, now on the National Register of Historic Places. In the early 1900s, it was a gathering place for Heights' residents to dance the night away.

Texas Gin, pineapple-rosemary shrub, dry vermouth, fresh lime juice, and agave syrup



Boulevard Buzz

Inspired by the master plan of The Boulevard (Now Heights Blvd) a promenade of elegance, vision, and the buzz of generations strolling under live oaks.

Texas Gin, strawberry shrub, fresh lemon juice, lavender syrup, orange bitters with a splash of Topo Chico



Mrs. Cooley's Cafetini

A bold nod to Helen Cooley, matriarch of the Heights, community builder, and quiet powerhouse behind The Woman's Club.

Texas white rum, Coffee Rum Liqueur, Bailey's, simple syrup, and cold brew



A Streetcar Named Honeybee

Named for the streetcars that once rolled gracefully down Heights Boulevard connecting Heights to downtown in style.

Texas white rum, honey, pineapple-rosemary shrub, fresh lemon juice, St-Germain, orange bitters with a splash of Topo Chico



The Heights Ironworks Rita

Queen Bee's Tea Room stands proudly inside the historic Ironworks Building. A true piece of Houston Heights history and a fully operational ironworks in its earliest days.

- Knickerbocker** - Rum, raspberry syrup, orange liqueur, and lemon juice
- Spicy Margarita** - Tequila, Cointreau, lime juice, and jalapeno syrup
- Paloma** - Tequila, lime juice, and grapefruit soda
- Old Fashioned** - Bourbon, simple syrup, angostura bitters
- Mint Julep** - Bourbon, simple syrup, and muddled mint
